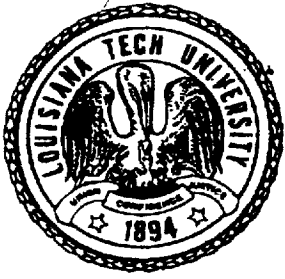

Application for Admission to Graduate School Louisiana Tech University

Your interest in attending the Graduate School at Louisiana Tech University is appreciated. Listed below are the application and admission requirements, important deadlines, application procedure, and contact information. Please review these completely. Applications will not be considered until all required materials have been submitted. All application materials become the property of the University and cannot be returned.

Application Requirements

All applicants are required to submit

- Completed application.
- Non-refundable application fee (\$20 for U.S. citizens, \$30 for International applicants).
- Official transcripts for all colleges or universities attended. (Transcripts of Tech course work need not be submitted.)

International applicants are also required to submit the following documents:

- TOEFL score of 550 or higher, not to be more than 2 years old.
- Official diplomas. Please note: You must have a four-year baccalaureate degree. If you hold a three-year bachelor's degree, you are not eligible for graduate study.
- Completed Affidavit of Support form.

It is recommended that all applicants submit the following materials with their application:

- Official GRE or GMAT scores.
- 3 Letters of Recommendation.

Application Deadlines

All application materials should be sent by the following dates. Applications received after these dates will be considered for the following Quarter.

Admission Requirements

Standardized tests are required by the various colleges. The Colleges of Applied & Natural Sciences, Education, Engineering & Science, and Liberal Arts require the Graduate Record Examination to be taken. The College of Administration & Business requires the Graduate Management Aptitude Test. Minimum scores differ depending on the program. Please contact the department you are applying to for specific requirements. A minimum overall grade point average of 2.25 is required for conditional admission, while a minimum grade point average of 2.5 is required for unconditional admission. There is no provisional admission available.

Application Procedure

Once a completed application is received by the Graduate School, the applicant will be notified of any admission documents which are missing. Upon receipt of all documents, your application will be reviewed by the Graduate School and the college you have applied to. You will be notified by letter of your admission status. International students who have a completed Affidavit of Support form and certified financial statement on file with the Graduate School will receive their immigration papers (I-20) after admission has been granted. The "Louisiana Privacy Act" of 1974 prohibits us from releasing any information concerning a student's application over the telephone, or to anyone but the student without prior written permission.
